PRELUDE.

CALEB SIMPER.

(Bells.) *rall.*

The prelude is written for piano in G major and 4/4 time. It consists of two staves. The right hand features a melodic line with eighth and sixteenth notes, while the left hand provides a harmonic accompaniment with chords and single notes. A 'rall.' (ritardando) marking is placed over the final few measures.
