The vocal parts are silent (rests) for the first four measures. From measure 5, they enter with a rhythmic pattern of eighth and sixteenth notes. The organ part begins at measure 5 with a sustained note on the bass pedal, followed by a series of eighth-note chords. Measure 6 shows a transition to a new section with a dynamic 'Andante.' and a different harmonic progression. Measures 7-8 show a return to the original tempo and harmonic pattern.
